Attractive Hope

Some instructions for the Lord's people ask more of us than rules can, take us farther, and lift us higher. "As you wish that others would do to you, do so to them," for example, or, "Be imitators of God, as beloved children" (Lk. 6:31; Eph. 5:1). Sayings like these compel us to apply the teachings we know.

An important instance of such a call is in play in our reading of Titus. Concluding a paragraph of guidelines for relating to various groups, the text summarizes, "So that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior" (Tit. 2:9). In other words, that is the point of the instructions that have been offered, and it is the principle to be honored where there is not a rule. "Make the doctrine of God attractive."

It seems to me that in Titus "the doctrine of God our Savior" especially focuses on his work to give us hope. The letter is written "in hope of eternal life"—that's what his word brings to light (1:2-3). Our lifestyle as people who belong to the Lord is defined by our "waiting for our blessed hope" (2:13). God's purpose in justifying us by his grace is even said to be that "we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life" (3:7).

One way, then, to understand the ethic that is meant guide us through difficult places and unusual times is this: make hope attractive. In everything, let the beautiful practical value of our hope of life stand out.

So what does attractive hope look like? "Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show perfect courtesy toward all people" (3:1-2).

Attractive hope looks like the grace from which it comes, being extended to people all around, in ordinary circumstances and in practical ways. Our calling is to bless the world with it.
