Making Himself Equal With God

Jesus, the humble servant and the teacher with no place to lay his head, had a perfect opportunity to correct a serious misconception about his identity—if it was a misconception. Those who were upset over what he did on the Sabbath, and at his calling God his Father, considered that he was making himself equal with God (Jn. 5:18). But, far from correcting that understanding, Jesus proceeded from it to make a series of breathtaking claims that emphasize his relation to the Father even more!

Dwell for a few moments on the impact of-and the implications within-these assertions by Jesus about his identity and standing as the Son of God.

- The Father loves him and shows him all that he is doing, and he does whatever he sees the Father doing (v.19-20).
- The Father raises the dead and gives them life, and he, the Son, likewise has life in himself and gives it to whom he will (v.21, 26).
- The Father, by right, can judge, but he has given the Son all authority to execute judgment, in part because he is the Son of God and the Son of Man (v.22, 25, 27).
- The Father is to be honored, but whoever does not honor the Son whom he has sent in the same way does not honor him (v.23).
- The Father can be believed and wants people to have eternal life, but it is those who hear the word of the Son and are responsive to his voice who pass from death to life (v.24, 25).

And, of course, the force of these claims only deepens as the subsequent material in the Gospel of John unfolds.

Jesus wasn't *making himself* equal with God. He *was* equal with God, and he was saying so. He was presenting himself as the lone known basis for passing from death to life (does anyone know of another one?). He was affirming that his own voice will call everyone to account, and that his voice will decide between life and judgment.

The setting of his claims within John 5 and 6 lends soberness and credibility to them. They are bracketed by the healing of a thirty-eight-year-invalid man at Jesus' word (5:5f), and by the feeding of five thousand from very little at his hand (6:1f). And, his right to make such claims is attested by the series of witnesses which are listed in the section following them (5:31f).

Jesus made himself the issue when he could've calmed the waters. He did it because he *is* the issue–the bread of life, the Holy One of God, the Savior of the world. May this Lord's day remind us what the issue really is.
