May God Give Us Wisdom

Any particular situation life brings our way may become either a trial or a temptation. That is the view of James. In fact, he uses the same term for both and lets a person's attitude toward the circumstance determine which it will be. A trial may be an experience met with joy and handled as testing that leads to stronger and more mature character (Js. 1:3-4). A temptation may be the same experience, but resented inwardly, stirred and moved along by one's own desire, until it results in some sinful word or deed (1:13-15).

To James, wisdom is the difference (1:5). Wisdom is the practical ability to apply what's known of God in the various circumstances of life. It comes from God through prayer to those who have a single-minded desire for it. Wisdom is understanding that's in keeping with long experience in godly living. It handles things as opportunities to stand the test and to be blessed (1:12).

Since both wisdom and the blessing it brings come from above, James knows it will express itself in conduct and spirit that's consistent with that origin (3:13). We shouldn't be in doubt about it either. Bitter jealousy, selfish ambition, and disorder: this is not the wisdom that comes from above (3:14 -16). Here's what wisdom from above is: it's first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere (3:17).

May the Father of lights, with every good gift and every perfect gift that is from above, give us also the wisdom that is from above (1:17). Equipped with it, may we meet the trials, stand the tests, and sow a harvest of righteousness in peace (3:18).
