(The following article was written in September 2001, shortly after the 9/11 incident. It seems as relevant now as it was then.)

"WE KNOW"

These are uncertain times. People wonder how events set in motion by an attack of terror will change our way of life and where they will take our world. No one knows what will happen next.

Into this environment comes a phrase which is prominent in the New Testament, and precious to Christians: "we know". These two little words express the confidence God's children have, even in the midst of a shaky world.

We know some things about the living God. We know that He loves us (I Jn. 4:16). We know His Son appeared in order to take away our sins (I Jn. 3:5). We know that in the Son we can come to the true God and have eternal life (I Jn. 5:20). We know that He hears our prayers, and that we have the petitions we have asked according to His will (I Jn. 5:15). We know that He works all things together for the good of His people (Rom. 8:28). We know that vengeance belongs to Him, and that He will repay (Heb. 10:30).

We know some things about life and how it ought to be lived. We know there is a difference between those who are of God and those who belong to the evil one (I Jn. 5:19). We know that God's children do not make sin a way of life (I Jn. 5:18). We know that we are supposed to love each other (I Jn. 3:14).

We know some things about the future. We know that when the Lord appears, we will see Him just as He is, and we will be like Him (I Jn. 3:2). That motivates us to keep ourselves pure through all that we do now.

Uncertainty? Yes, there is plenty of that right now. But it is what we <u>do</u> know that gives us blessed assurance. Let's hold on to what we know?
