Psalm 92 is a wonderful psalm to draw us into our time of worship. Actually, it would be a fantastic psalm to begin every day with, "It is good to give thanks for the LORD, to sing praises to the Most High. It is good to proclaim your unfailing love in the morning, your faithfulness in the evening ... "The psalmist reminds us of what we already know - our place before the LORD as the recipients of his blessing.

The psalmist continues this declaration by following his own advice. He praises all that the LORD has done for him and for all those who believe. The rest of the psalm discusses the character of the LORD and lists the ways he has seen the LORD be a blessing to his people.

What if each Sunday we all spent our morning before worship reflecting on this psalm? One step further, what if we all engaged in the creation of a new psalm modeled after psalm 92 but filled with the ways WE have seen the LORD work in our lives and in the lives of his people. What if we spent every morning praising the LORD for who he is and reflecting on who we ought to be in response?

This morning we invite you to join us in praising the Most High!


