### **Increasing Faith**

"Increase our faith!" and, "Your faith has made you well." That's sort of how our reading for this Lord's day begins and ends (Lk. 17:5; 18:42). The first is the apostles' appeal to the Lord; the second is his assurance to a blind beggar. Surely we identify with the former statement and long to hear the latter. If so, we might take what happens in between them as instruction about how transformation from one to the other occurs.

Faith increases as we are simply attending to our duty. The apostles' exclamation was their response what Jesus commanded about forgiving (17:4). His answer indicates that even when they had done it, they would still only be unworthy servant who had done their duty, for they themselves had been forgiven many times (17:10).

It's when what we do is compelled by gratitude that faith increases. One fellow, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and, praising God with a loud voice, fell on his face at the feet of Jesus and thanked him (17:15-16). He was exercising his faith; it could grow (17:19).

Increasing faith occupies itself with the rule of God in the ordinary events of everyday life. It sees that his kingdom is within us, among us in the person of Christ, in our midst wherever he is obeyed (17:21). Faith deepens as we're following him rather than while we're fascinated with times and events.

Faith increases in the lives of humble people who pray without losing heart. It was the persistent widow who had faith (18:8), and it was the tax collector humbly pleading for mercy who was justified (18:14). Contrary to what we'd expect, maturing faith receives the kingdom of God like a little child (18:17).

It's when we'll leave anything for the sake of the kingdom of God, with the conviction that it's more than worth it, that faith has been increasing toward its object (18:29-30). We are, after all, following one who endured everything that can be endured before he arose (18:31-33).

Our faith will have made us well when we, as beneficiaries of his mercy, follow him in front of everybody, no matter what, honoring God through him (18:43). I am very thankful to be around a group of people like you who seeking to that very thing.
