You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. (Matt. 5:14)

Great!

In daily conversation, "great" may be an overused adjective, or an exclamation of delight or frustration, or an accurate description when there's just no better word. In Acts, "great" is used in this last way several times with reference to the progress of the gospel and the experience of the church. These instances are instructive, especially when considered together.

What are the "great" things in the church's life? "Great power" with which the apostles bore witness to the Lord; not their own power, but the Spirit's, to confirm their words and to enable us, even now, to believe them (Acts 4:33a; cf. 6:8; 8:13). "Great grace" upon everyone, both as favor from God and kindness toward each other (4:33b, 34; 11:23). "Great fear," the sense of awe and respect that goes with awareness of God's judgment (5:5, 11). "Great persecution," and even "great lamentation," such as the church endured with the loss of Stephen (8:1, 2). And the "great joy" associated with the good news of Christ and its fruit in the hearts and lives of people (8:8; 15:3).

It's an unusual mixture of blessings, attitudes, actions, and experiences, isn't it? But it's also a balanced portrayal of spiritual health and vitality. The Lord is present and involved, and his people are responding to him and continuing with him. And, though, they are just regular people, the outcomes are in many ways "great."

It's interesting that they aren't "great" in the measurements so often applied now—organizations, structures, programs, and so forth. What's really "great" is a group of people in right relationship with the Lord, and whose hearts, lives, and relationships correspond to that reality. That is a "mega" (the word translated "great" or "much") church, the kind of one each congregation of the Lord's people surely wants to be.
