This Week

In our Sunday morning meeting this week, we're considering another of the most wonderful passages in the Bible. It speaks to one of our most persistent questions, too. What happens when word of Jesus and the resurrection enters an environment of intellectual superiority and secular idolatry? The longings of the soul don't go away, and, as we'll see, the Lord's people have answers for them.

As you know, we're in the process of adding deacons to assist us in "welcoming, serving, and growing in Jesus." Both weather and illness has interfered with our three-part Wednesday evening series. The points we tried to make this past week are: 1) the Lord has given us a description of those who can serve well in this role; 2) it pictures normal and healthy followers of Christ, not extraordinary and rare individuals; and 3) a congregation is obligated to evaluate by this standard, which requires goodwill, thought and communication. If you missed it, you can access the class through our website. If the weather turns out to be bad again this time, we'll let you know about the timing of the next one.
