# **Intrapersonal Skills**

The ability to understand personal emotions, and use that understanding to develop self-discipline, self control and to learn from experience.

# **Interpersonal Skills**

These allow the individual to work with others, develop friendships through communication, cooperation, negotiation, sharing, empathizing and listening.



# **Systemic Skills**

Give the ability to respond to the limits and consequences of everyday life with responsibility, adaptability, flexibility and integrity.

# **Judgmental Skills**

Use the ability to use wisdom  
to evaluate situations  
according to appropriate  
values.
